#### PLANT

Plant roses with full sunlight Do not place too close to trees or large shrubs

# PRUNE/WEED

Prune roses back Remove dead or over-stressed foliage Clean up all leaves and petals and discard Pull and Remove all weeds around roses Apply 2 - 3 inches of mulch

\*Do not prune climbing varieties

## FERTILIZE

**Regular fertilizing** is required for optimal blooms **Fertilize** with a dry slow-release product

#### Recommendations

Moon Dust - All-purpose fertilizer SuperCharged Moon Juice - Growth enhancer



**Deep water** your roses at least once a week Be sure the entire root is watered (16 in. deep)

To conserve water, **apply** 2 - 4 in. of mulch at the base of your roses
